



GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

Specific Conditions for Axe Throwing (FriAxe)

These conditions supplement the General Terms and Conditions of Sale of FriBowling SA.

1. Minimum Age

- Traditional axe throwing is available to participants aged 12 and over.
- Participants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible adult aged 18 or over, who must remain on the premises for the entire duration of the activity.
- Velcro targets are available to children aged 8 and over, subject to the opening hours and conditions defined by FriBowling SA.

2. Liability Waiver

- Each participant must complete and sign a liability waiver before every session.
- For participants under the age of 18, the waiver must be signed by their legal representative or the responsible accompanying adult.
- A new waiver must be signed before each participation.
- Refusal to sign the liability waiver will result in the participant being unable to take part in the activity.
- In such cases, the booked service remains payable in full.

3. Conditions of Participation

- Participants must be physically and medically fit to take part in the activity.
- Any person whose condition or behaviour is deemed incompatible with the proper conduct of the activity or the safety of participants may be refused access or excluded from the activity without refund.
- Any participant who refuses to attend the safety briefing or follow staff instructions may be refused access to the activity.

4. Mandatory Equipment

- Closed-toe shoes are mandatory.
- Sandals, flip-flops, open shoes or any equipment deemed unsuitable may result in refusal of participation.
- In such cases, the booked service remains payable in full.

5. Safety

- Participants agree to comply with the safety instructions provided by staff and the rules displayed in the throwing areas.
- Only one person at a time is permitted in the throwing area.
- Participants must remain behind the safety line until all throwers have completed their round and have been authorised to retrieve their axes.
- Axes may only be handled as part of the activity and in accordance with the instructions provided.
- Spectators and accompanying persons must also comply with all safety instructions.
- Any person behaving in a dangerous or inappropriate manner may be excluded immediately without refund.
- Participants are personally liable for any property damage caused intentionally or through negligence.
- FriBowling SA reserves the right to change the allocation of participants between the different throwing lanes for safety, organisational or operational reasons.

6. Acceptance

- Any booking implies full and unconditional acceptance of these specific conditions as well as the General Terms and Conditions of Sale of FriBowling SA.
